## Tell me about accessibility

Pathways & stairs - the main alumni activities are based in Town Square which is outdoors and has an asphalt surface. There are several areas that are one step up or down from the main level Town Square. It is mostly flat and able to be navigated with a wheelie walker. We recommend that anyone using a wheelie walker is dropped off at the Town Square Drop & Go Zone, entry from McCaul Street. The 4pm School Tour is designed to be a stair-free tour and accessible to alumni with wheelie walkers.

Auslan Interpreters - qualified and experienced interpreters are scheduled to be at the 5pm and 6pm School Tours and also at the 6pm Trivia Competition held in the Peter Doherty Theatre. There are also interpreters scheduled at the Main Stage for live music on the school oval. You can visit the Auslan Information marquee beside the Main Stage for interpreter support and event information.
